Two weeks of the term are done and we have had a great start to the new year. Students are settled in classes and teaching and learning programmes are up and running. One of the important parts of our programmes is working out where students are with their learning. This happens through many methods from formal testing to observations of student work in the classroom and samples of the work they produce. This helps us to work out what the student's next steps are for learning and design activities to move them forward. Spelling testing has been undertaken this week and part of the new Structured Literacy approach and targeted teaching has also begun. Over the next few weeks, we will be undertaking Progressive Achievement Tests or PAT's that many of you will have completed when you were at school. These will cover Mathematics, Reading Comprehension and Listening Comprehension. Results from these initial tests will be shared with parents to help you understand where your child is at with their learning but also to help plan teaching programmes.

We have begun teaching with the new Oxford Structured Maths programme. More information will be shared about this as we progress during the year but Structured Literacy will be our main priority to start the year.

Next week will be a busy one for the Year 7-8 Team with the first of our trips for the year, starting with the Bike Trip to Ngāmotu Beach. This is always a fun day and a great way to face the challenge of a long bike ride by showing tū māia. The Year 7-8 Team will also begin their Technology programme which starts on Friday. This year they will be learning in the areas of Manufacturing, Visual Arts, Music, Textiles, Hospitality and Enterprises/Digital Technology.

The Year 4-6 classes are in the process of selecting their Class Councillors who will be announced at our first celebration assembly next Friday 14 February. With the capacity restrictions in the hall, we will be holding our Celebration Assemblies in two parts with a Year 4-8 assembly at 9:30am and a Year 0-3 assembly at 10:00am. Once again, the assemblies will be led by our fantastic Student Leaders who are looking forward to taking on various roles in the assembly and around the school. Parents are welcome to attend Celebration Assemblies so please do join us if you are able.
