12 Points Required to Complete Project			

1 Point Task 1	Self Portrait Draw a pencil self-portrait. You must show tone/value by using shading.
2 Points Task 2	Photography Challenge Go on a photo shoot. Select a topic and take a series of photos. Present a minimum of 15 of your best photos in hard copy. Include a paragraph about your selected topic. You must be the photographer!
1 Point Task 3	Magazine Montage Use magazine pictures and photos to create a montage. You should be trying to convey a message of some description. This can be 2D or 3D, with a maximum size A4.
1 Point Task 4	Pattern Making Create an Artwork entirely by using 'pattern' e.g. Koru, Kowhaiwhai, Zendoodle etc. Maximum size A3.
2 Points Task 5	Mask Making Make a mask. You can choose the materials, such as papier mache or plaster of paris. The mask must be made from scratch.
1 Point Task 6	Character Illustrations Illustrate a character (real or imaginary). Include their characteristics as part of the design. You should include a heading and an explanation. Maximum size A4.
2 Points Task 7	Kiwi Artist Study Present a study on a New Zealand Artist. This can be in a format of your choice. It should include illustration, information IN YOUR OWN WORDS, and a bibliography. Maximum size A3.
2 Points Task 8	Colour Wheel Present a chart showing the primary, secondary and complementary colours. Include a section on colour mixing and the colour wheel. Maximum size A3
2 Points Task 9	Sculpture Making Make a 3-D clay sculpture. Try using Das, pumice, plasticine, or clay. Your options are limitless.

1 Point Task 10	Comic Strip Make a comic strip. It should be a story with a beginning, middle and an end. Please use a variety of angles and viewpoints to communicate your story. Maximum size A3.
2 Points Task 11	Nature Collage Make a collage using natural materials. You should research collage on the internet for ideas.
3 Points Task 12	Art History Research Create an Art History timeline to show Art movements and the major Artists. You should include major events in history as well. There should be some images included as well.
3 Points Task 13	Acrylic Painting Complete a painting on a topic of your choice on canvas. Using acrylic paint. Use paint mixing and techniques.
2 Points Task 14	Recycled Sculpture Make a 3-D sculpture from recycled materials. Include diagrams to make your designs clear.
2 Points Task 15	Wearable Arts Design (NOT MAKE) 4 Wearable Arts Designs. Be specific about materials used. Include diagrams and colour to make your designs clear and detailed.
