12 Points Required to Complete Project			

1 Point	Self Portrait
Task 1	Draw a pencil self-portrait. You must show tone/value by using shading.
2 Points	Photography Challenge
Task 2	Go on a photo shoot. Select a topic and take a series of photos. Present a minimum of 15 of your best photos in hard copy. Include a paragraph about your selected topic. You must be the photographer!
1 Point	Magazine Montage
Task 3	Use magazine pictures and photos to create a montage. You should be trying to convey a message of some description. This can be 2D or 3D, with a maximum size A4.
1 Point	Pattern Making
Task 4	Create an Artwork entirely by using 'pattern' e.g. Koru, Kowhaiwhai, Zendoodle etc. Maximum size A3.
2 Points	Mask Making
Task 5	Make a mask. You can choose the materials, such as papier mache or plaster of paris. The mask must be made from scratch.
1 Point	Character Illustrations
Task 6	Illustrate a character (real or imaginary). Include their characteristics as part of the design. You should include a heading and an explanation. Maximum size A4.
2 Points	Kiwi Artist Study
Task 7	Present a study on a New Zealand Artist. This can be in a format of your choice. It should include illustration, information IN YOUR OWN WORDS, and a bibliography. Maximum size A3.
2 Points	Colour Wheel
Task 8	Present a chart showing the primary, secondary and complementary colours. Include a section on colour mixing and the colour wheel. Maximum size A3
2 Points	Sculpture Making
Task 9	Make a 3-D clay sculpture. Try using Das, pumice, plasticine, or clay. Your options are limitless.

1 Point	Comic Strip
Task 10	Make a comic strip. It should be a story with a beginning, middle and an end. Please use a variety of angles and viewpoints to communicate your story. Maximum size A3.
2 Points	Nature Collage
Task 11	Make a collage using natural materials. You should research collage on the internet for ideas.
3 Points	Art History Research
Task 12	Create an Art History timeline to show Art movements and the major Artists. You should include major events in history as well. There should be some images included as well.
3 Points	Acrylic Painting
Task 13	Complete a painting on a topic of your choice on canvas. Using acrylic paint. Use paint mixing and techniques.
2 Points	Recycled Sculpture
Task 14	Make a 3-D sculpture from recycled materials. Include diagrams to make your designs clear.
2 Points	Wearable Arts
Task 15	Design (NOT MAKE) 4 Wearable Arts Designs. Be specific about materials used. Include diagrams and colour to make your designs clear and detailed.
