1 Point Task 1	Reo Rangatira Translate “Reo Rangatira” and write a paragraph about what it means to you.
2 Points Task 2	Whakatauki Display Choose a whakatauki. Write it up and share it in a poster or art piece for display. Write down what it means to you.
2 Points Task 3	Māori Instruments Choose three traditional Māori instruments and write a paragraph on each about how these instruments were used. Include diagrams / pictures.
3 Points Task 4	Influential Person Write a biography of an influential person of Māori descent. Maximum of 2 pages of typed/handwritten information. Include pictures/photos. Also include a bibliography that shows where you got your information from.
2 Points Task 5	Waka Landings Draw an A3 map of Aotearoa that shows where the 7 wakas landed. Mark in the following landmarks using an appropriate key: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tamaki Makau-rau ● Taupo Nui a tia, Rotorua ● Ngāmotu ● Heretaunga ● Ahuriri ● Kirikiriroa ● Otautahi ● Otepoti ● Te Whanga-nui-a-Tara ● Tūranga-nui-a-Kiwa ● Waihopai ● Whakatū.

2 Points Task 6	Tikanga Māori <p>Make an information poster that promotes Tikanga māori.</p>
2 Points Task 7	Māori Legends and Gods <p>Choose a māori legend or god to research and present your findings on a poster or slideshow.</p>
1 Point Task 8	Māori Celebrations <p>Research and explain one of the Māori celebrations that take every year (e.g. Puanga).</p>
