

	Your task is to research an Aotearoa myth or legend and retell it in your own words
Optional Task 1	using a creative format. Choose one of the following ways to bring the story to life:
	Create a booklet – Write and illustrate the myth in a small book format. Code it on Scratch – Use Scratch to create an interactive retelling of the myth. Make a video – Act it out, animate it, or create a narrated slideshow. Write a script or screenplay – Script out a scene as if it were a play or movie.
	Research: Find a Aotearoa myth that interests you. Some examples include:
	 The Great Fish of Maui Rona and The Moon The Battle of The Mountains The Legend of Creation
	Retell the story in your own words. Make sure your version is clear, engaging, and true to the spirit of the original myth.
	Se creative! Use illustrations, animations, voiceovers, or dramatic elements to bring the story to life.
1 Point	Be a designer
Optional Task 2	Your task is to design a poster that promotes Bell Block School. Your poster should be eye-catching, informative, and highlight what makes our school a great place to learn!
	Your poster must include:
	 ✓ The school name – Make sure "Bell Block School" is clearly visible. ✓ Our school values – Include the key values that guide our learning community. ✓ What makes Bell Block School special – Showcase the strengths of our school, such as learning opportunities, community spirit, sports, or other activities.
	Design requirements:
	Be creative! Use colors, images, and fonts that make your poster stand out. Size limit: Your poster should be no larger than A4 (21cm x 29.7cm).
	Make sure your design is clear, engaging, and represents Bell Block School proudly!
1 Point	Quiz Master: Create a Bell Block School Kahoot!
Optional Task 3	Your task is to design a general knowledge Kahoot all about Bell Block School ! Your quiz should be fun, engaging, and full of interesting facts that will challenge your

classmates.

Requirements:

- A minimum of 20 questions Make sure they are meaningful and interesting. No "yes or no" questions – Challenge players with multiple-choice or open-ended questions.
- Correct spelling and punctuation Double-check your work for accuracy.
- An image for each question Use relevant pictures to make your quiz more engaging.

Final Steps:

- **Test your quiz** Make sure all answers are correct and the game runs smoothly. Show your completed Kahoot to your teacher for approval.
- **B** Host a Kahoot session Have your classmates play your quiz and see who comes out on top!

Cartography Challenge: Redraw a Map of Bell Block School

Your task is to **create a clear and detailed map** of Bell Block School, making sure it's easy to read and includes key locations around the school. You will redraw the map on one A4 piece of paper.

Your map must include:

Classroom Locations:

- Your own classroom
- At least 1 classroom from each of the Year 0-3, 4-6, and 7-8 classrooms

Important School Spaces:

- DP's office
- Principal's office
- Fields, turf, basketball court, and sports shed
- Bell Block Hall
- Library
- Office

Map Features:

🜎 Labels: Think carefully about how to label each space, ensuring the map is useful

for someone unfamiliar with the school. Consistent Writing: Ensure all writing is clear and the same style (e.g., all caps or all lowercase). **Border:** Draw a neat border around your map. **Rey:** Include a key that explains any symbols or colors used on the map. Title: Add a title to your map, such as "Map of Bell Block School."

Important Notes:

- Take your time to make the map as accurate and clear as possible.
- Ensure the layout of the map reflects the actual layout of the school grounds.

Your map should help someone find their way around the school easily!
